Scholarship Program

It is Haggerty Construction, Inc.'s (HCI) desire to financially assist High School Seniors currently participating in a Construction or related Vocational/Technical program who desire to further their education in a four-year College or advanced Technical/Trade school. These students have the ability to apply for and, potentially, receive monies in the way of the Haggerty Construction, Inc. Scholarship. HCI hopes to help those deserving students attain their educational goals, meet their professional objectives, and succeed to their fullest ability.

Scholarship Consideration Criteria:

Eligible Applicants

- Academic achievement by maintaining at least a 2.0 GPA during their High/Technical School Career
- High School Seniors currently enrolled in full-time ABET or ACE accredited construction or civil/construction engineering program.
- High School Seniors or Seniors in a Vocational/Technical Institute working with curriculum specific to the building/construction industry and desire to further their knowledge and advance their career by entering a four-year College or advanced Technical/Trade school. Curriculum shall include, but is not limited to:
 - Construction
 - Engineering
 - Architecture
 - Project Management
 - Planning
 - Urban/Rural Land Development
 - Interior or Landscape Design

Funding Considerations

- Financial need
- Community / Extracurricular involvement
- Leadership in Clubs, Groups, or Organizations
- Participation in Construction or related field activities
- Any awards and/or recognition
- Work history (or school projects)
- Personal or family history that dictates need
- Total available scholarship funds: **\$5,000.00**
- The top Ten students will be available for funding consideration
- Potential internship with Haggerty Construction for the 2017 summer

Award Restrictions

- Full-time student
- **85%** attendance rate

Geographic Restrictions

- San Joaquin County

Procedural Administration:

Application Procedures

The information requested on the application should reflect the selection criteria designated for the scholarship program. The following items below should address any applicant questions:

- **When and where are the applications available?**
 - Available March 6, 2017 at HCI's website www.haggertyconstruction.net, the San Joaquin County Office of Education, and school counselors offices throughout the county
- **When are the applications due?**
 - All applications are to be postmarked no later than Friday, May 26, 2017
- **Where should the application be sent? How many copies are needed?**
 - One copy should be kept for the applicants records
 - One copy must be mailed or delivered to:

- **What, if any, additional information/documents should accompany this application?**
 - An in-depth description and example of any relevant Senior or graduation required project
 - Additional reference letters from former high school educators or a current work relevant employer
- **How and when will the award winners be notified?**
 - The winners shall be notified via email and physical mail postmarked no later than Monday, May 1, 2017
- **How and when will the awards be disbursed?**
 - Disbursement shall come at an award lunch for all scholarship recipients
 - A check in the applicants name for the selected amount will be given at the luncheon
 - In the event the student is unable to attend the luncheon, the check will be mailed to the recipient

Selection Policies and Procedures

The selection process shall include 5 team members from HCI who will read, review, and provide feedback to the selection board.

The Scholarship Board shall meet two (2) times during the vetting process and shall make the final decisions by vote on the second (2nd) meeting no later than Friday, June 9, 2017. Notifications shall be sent to all recipients within two business days.

Monitoring Student Progress

Student grades, attendance, and overall standing within each institution shall be monitored two times during the award selection process; once at the initial application date and once more at the final award selection. This is to provide a fair and even assessment to all applicants. Should someone fail to meet the standards for the entire duration, another applicant will take their place.

Administrative and Fiscal Reporting

The scholarship shall be properly monitored through a designated individual at HCI. They shall follow all applicable rules and reporting provided and monitored by the IRS.

Public Awareness

Haggerty Construction shall provide notice to all potential applicants through several campaigns:

- Haggerty Website
 - The website shall have a portal where applicants can print the application and any other pertinent information
- San Joaquin County Office of Education
 - Haggerty Construction shall work with the SJCOE to provide all information relevant to all students eligible for the award
- School Applications
 - Haggerty Construction shall provide an application to all eligible schools in San Joaquin County

Conclusion:

There is a need in San Joaquin County to keep and create a more professional network of construction industry experts. The profession sorely needs more scholarship programs to help educate and train future professionals and leaders.
